



Privacy Notice

This Privacy Notice explains how SOAVE PRIVATE INVESTORS SA (the “Company”), Via G. Cattori 12, 6900 Lugano, Switzerland, processes personal data through this website (the “Site”), in accordance with the Swiss Federal Act on Data Protection (“FADP”). By accessing or using the Site, you acknowledge that personal data may be processed as described in this Privacy Notice.

When you visit or use the Site, the Company may process personal data such as technical browsing data (including IP address, access time, browser and device information, language settings and server logs), data voluntarily provided by you (including name, surname, email address, telephone number and the content of messages sent through contact forms or email), data collected through cookies and similar technologies, and security-related data processed through tools used to protect the Site against abuse or automated access. The Company processes such data to ensure the proper operation and security of the Site, to respond to requests and communications, to comply with legal and regulatory obligations, to protect its legitimate interests.

The Company processes personal data in compliance with the FADP and, depending on the circumstances, on the basis of pre-contractual steps, legal or regulatory obligations, overriding legitimate interests, or your consent where required (for example, for certain non-essential cookies or tools). Personal data may be disclosed, where necessary, to external IT, hosting, website maintenance, security and support providers, and competent authorities or courts where required by law.

Personal data processed through the Site is processed in Switzerland. The Company uses service providers located in Switzerland for the operation, security and maintenance of the Site. The Company does not transfer personal data abroad in connection with the Site, unless required by applicable law or by a specific request or service explicitly accepted by the user.



Personal data is retained only for as long as necessary for the purposes described above and in accordance with applicable legal and regulatory requirements. The retention period may vary depending on the category of data, the purpose of processing, and any applicable statutory, regulatory, evidentiary or compliance obligations. Once personal data is no longer required for the relevant purpose, it will be deleted or anonymised, unless further retention is required or permitted by applicable law.

The Site is not intended to collect personal data requiring special protection within the meaning of the FADP, unless necessary and based on an appropriate legal basis. If you voluntarily submit such data (for example, by email or through a contact form), the Company will process it only to the extent necessary to handle your request and in accordance with applicable law.

The Company implements appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect personal data against unauthorised access, loss, misuse, alteration or disclosure.

The Company may amend this Privacy Notice from time to time, and the version published on the Site from time to time shall prevail.”
